II. Background Information

The Transformational Governance project in Somalia is a foundational initiative to kick-off the implementation of the National Transformation Plan (NTP) 2025-2029 and will be contributing factor for driving the institutional reforms envisioned under the NTP. The project will focus on policy, regulatory frameworks and institutional capacity strengthening activities as well as support innovations towards a more accountable, agile and anticipatory governance and mechanisms at all levels from Federal Government to the Federal member States for a strengthened governance ecosystem.

This role aims to streamline investment processes, attract responsible investments, and support economic transformation initiatives.

III. Position Summary

The Investment Facilitation Technical Officer will work at the Ministry of Planning, Investment and Economic Development under the direct supervision of the Director of Investment Promotion Department and generally to the Director General of the Ministry.

The role of the Investment Facilitation Technical Officer is crucial in advancing the objectives of the Transformational Governance Program. This position plays a pivotal role in facilitating investments, enhancing economic growth, and promoting sustainable development through efficient coordination and strategic facilitation.

The Officer will provide support to SOMINVEST on investment facilitation analysis and strengthening the capacity of the investment department in the promotion of NTP and the implementation of the National Investment Strategy as a Government Activity Program.

- Coordinate with stakeholders to facilitate investment opportunities aligned with NTP priorities.
- Provide technical support in investment promotion, including the development of investment attraction strategies and the facilitation of investment partnerships.
- Conduct research and analysis on investment trends, market opportunities, and investment facilitation best practices.
- Collaborate with the Somalia Investment Promotion Agency (SOMINVEST) to develop and implement gender-sensitive investment strategies and international partnerships.
- Conduct market assessments, monitor industry developments, and gather data to identify new investment opportunities and potential threats.
- Document investment and aftercare case studies and monitor investment data to support the preparation of reports and strategic planning.
- Deliver technical assistance and training programs to stakeholders on investment facilitation procedures and related policy issues.
- Provide research, analysis, and policy development support on issues related to trade, customs, and investment facilitation.
- Provide all the necessary technical support to the sectoral and research teams.
